Dear Parents,

We are always working to develop our children's ability to follow oral directions. Listening is the basic source of all learning. The children were told to draw specific things next to each number. We used our problem solving technique ( LISTEN, then STOP, THINK about what you were told and then DO.)

These were the oral directions...

1. Draw 3 red apples.
2. Draw 5 blue circles.
3. Draw 1 sun and 2 clouds.
4. Draw 4 purple triangles.
5. Draw 3 yellow flowers and 1 orange flower.

\*Some children work too slowly and fall behind. We encourage them to work neatly but at a reasonable pace as not to miss the next direction.

\*Some children are perfectionists and spend time trying to make their drawing "just so". We tell them that only God is perfect.

\*Some children scribble to rush through it. We tell them that they are big boys/girls now and should take pride in all that they do.
