




Dear Parents,


As you guide your children with their handwriting at home and review the formation of the letters, please be aware that some lowercase letters are written in a specific way. For example, a few of our smaller letters are created by first writing the letter "c" and then adding other lines.

① "a" - written as "c" with a line straight down ex C:

② "d" - written as "c" with a long line not → 


③ "g" - written as "c" with a hanging "j" not → 

④ "q" - written as "c" with a backward "l" or "L" not → 


Children have tendency to create these letters by making an "o" first instead of a "c". Please guide them.


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
