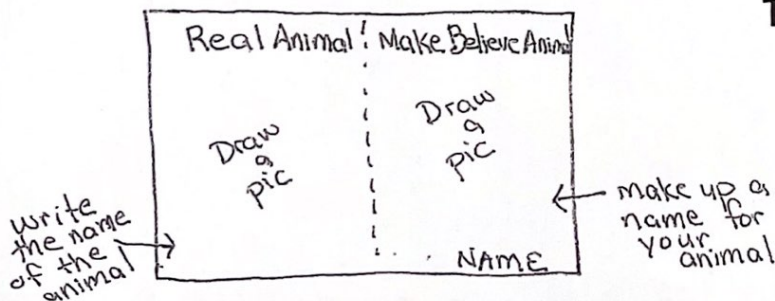
Dear Parents,

All projects will be displayed in the hallway for all to see!

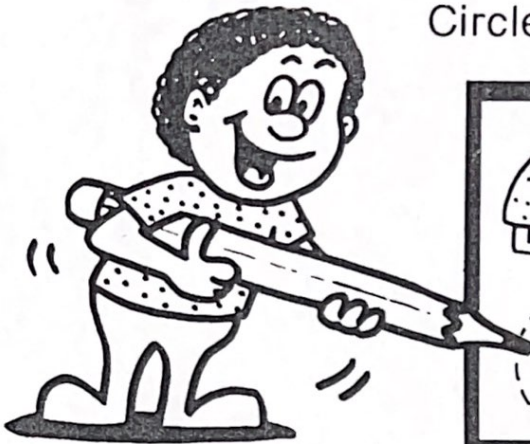
