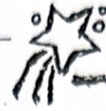

Short-a sound



Abby's Apples



Vowels can make more than one sound. Each vowel has a short sound and a long sound. **Short a** makes the sound you hear at the beginning of **apple**. To help you remember the short-a sound, stretch out the beginning of the word like this: a-a-a-apple.

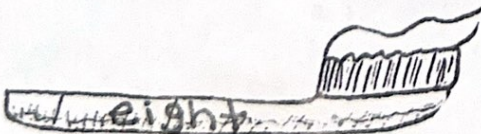
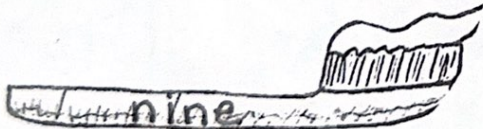
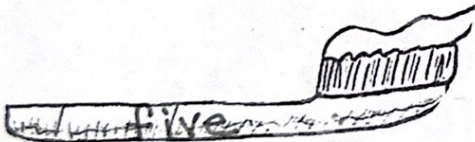
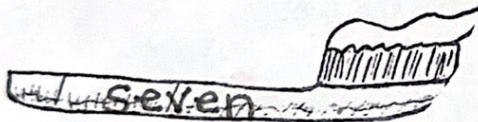
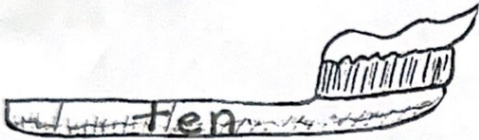
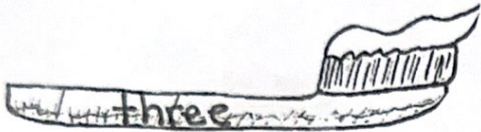
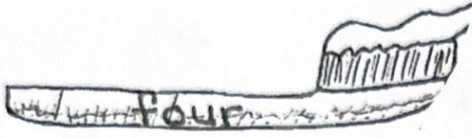
