Tonight for homework, the children are asked to practice writing their names.

On the 1st line, I have written their proper names. They should rewrite it on the following lines (~~including the back~~ ~~for a total of 8 times~~) Only the 1st letter in their name is capital - all the rest are lowercase. We are also trying to remain on the proper lines so that our letters are uniform.

Capital letters take a full space. Lowercase letters take a half space (except for letters like b, d, f, h, k, l, t) ex

b d f h k l t

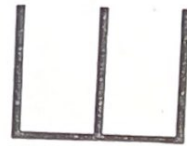
Some letters hang off the bottom line (such as g, j, p, q, y) ex

g j p q y

























ex: John (✓) John (x)

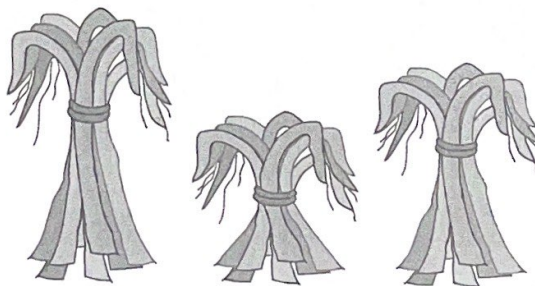
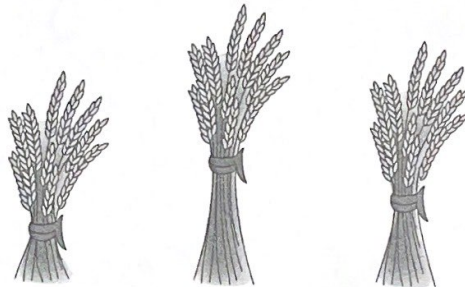
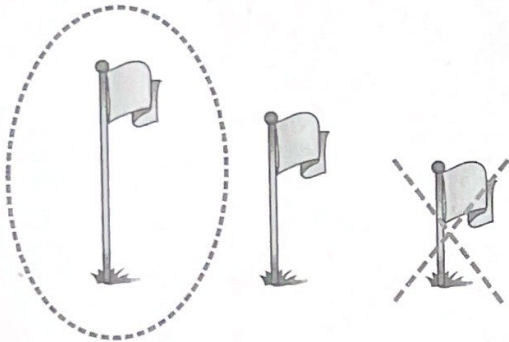
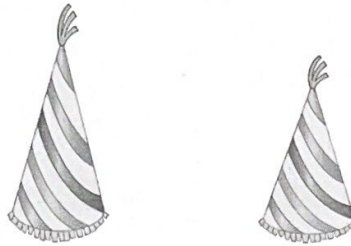
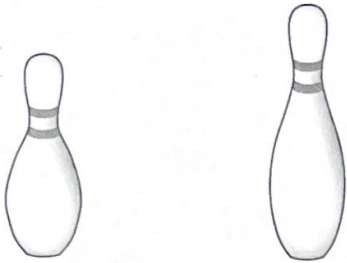
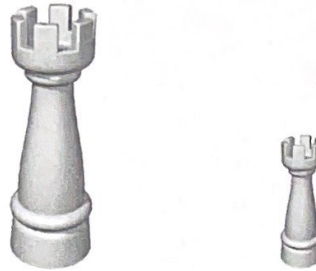
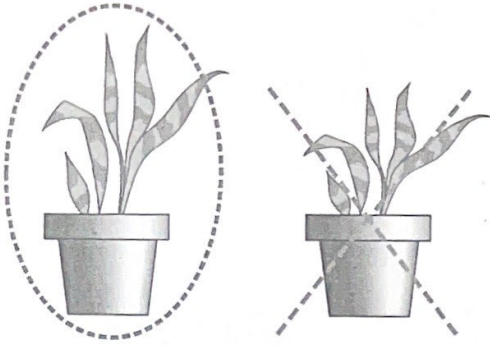
Compare Length
